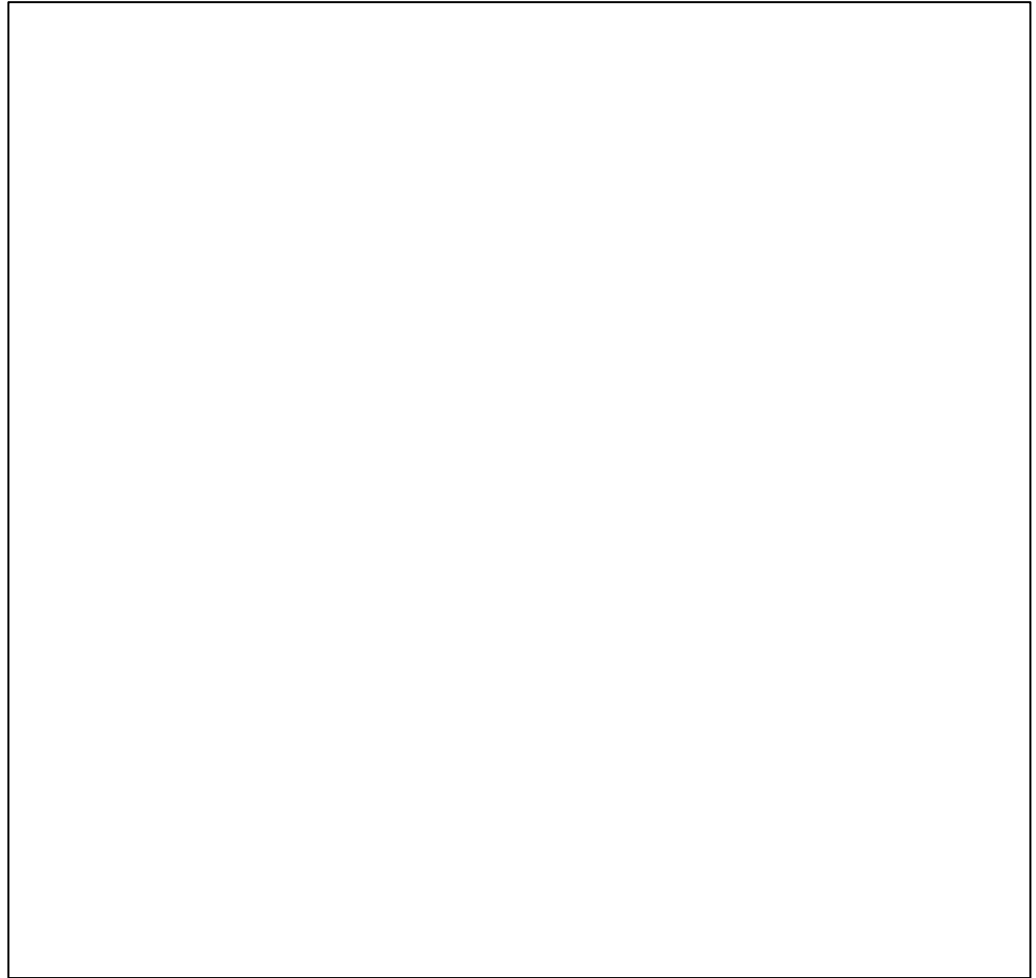

in your hair.

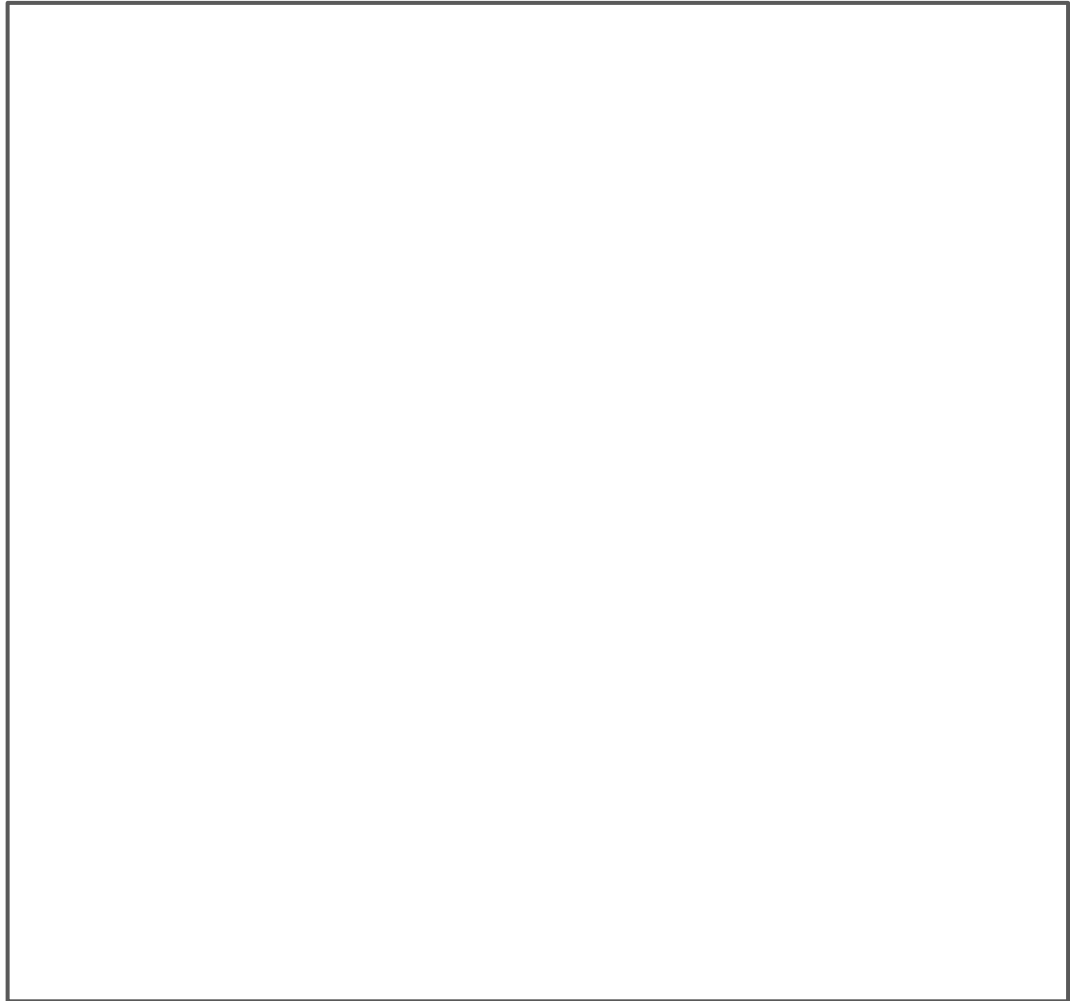


# Skunk Smell

that the skunk smell goes.

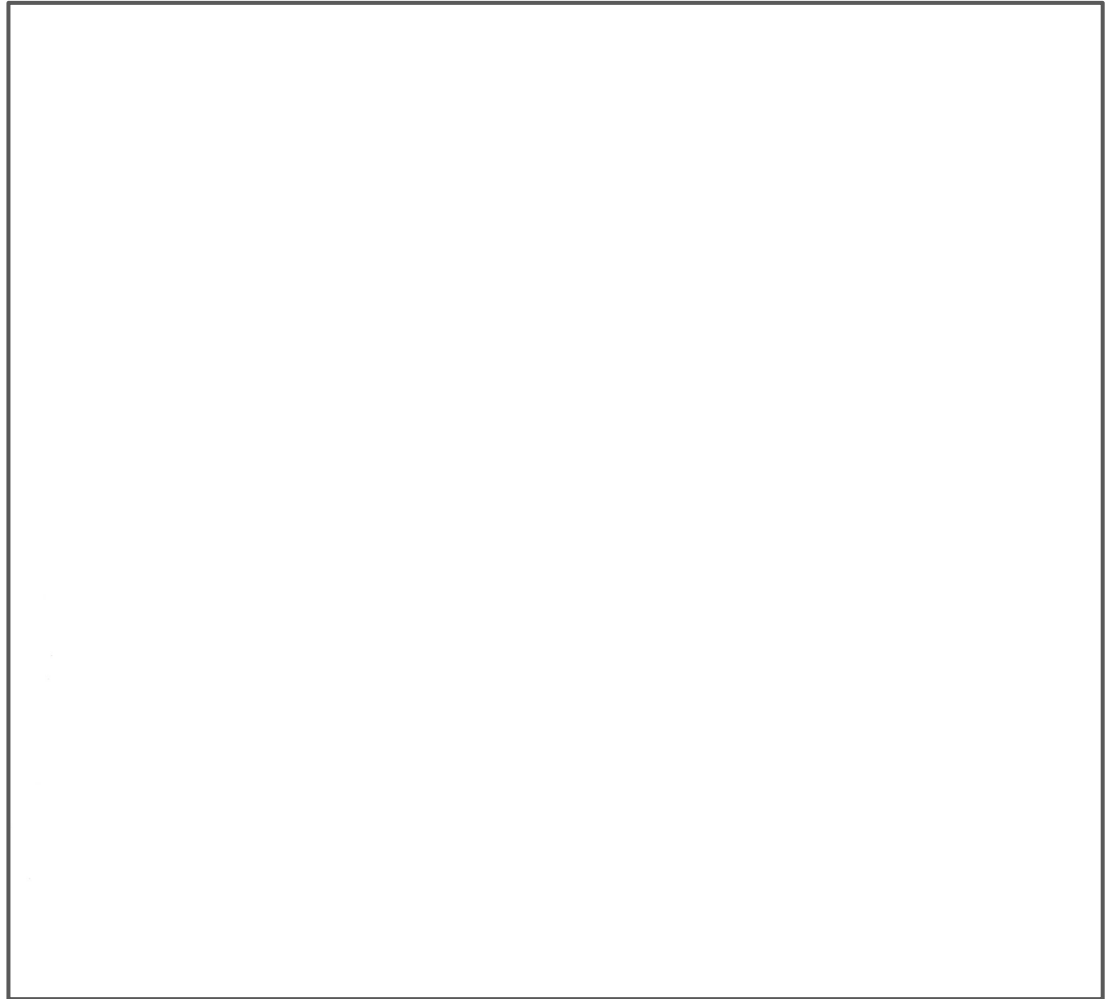


# Big Mistake
