Cohort Entry 2020 Consultation Update

Following consultation with parents, prospective parents, staff and Early Childhood providers, the Board has confirmed the adoption of a 'Cohort Entry' Policy from 2020 onwards.

The Cohort entry dates for next year are shown below. Under this policy, children turning 5 will commence school at the next available Cohort Entry date following their 5th birthday.

Term 1: Monday 3rd February / Monday 9th March
Term 2: Tuesday 28th April / Monday 1st June
Term 3: Monday 20th July / Monday 24th August
Term 4: Monday 12th October / Monday 16th November







The Cohort Entry Policy comes into effect from Term 1 next year will **only apply to children** *turning 5.* It will <u>not apply</u> to children 6 years of age or older, nor will it affect the decision of whether or not 5 year old children with April/May birthdays move into Year 1 or Year 2 the following year.
