I would particularly like to welcome new staff, families and students who will join our school for the first time, who we will welcome with a traditional Pōwhiri at 10am on the first day.

In the current situation, I know everyone will be mindful of the COVID testing that is currently underway, but it is encouraging news that no new cases of community transmission have been reported today. Despite the heightened vigilance, I can tell you that the staff are as enthused, energised and raring to go as ever, with plenty of exciting and engaging events and activities to look forward to. Further information and key dates for the Term ahead will be sent home next week.
