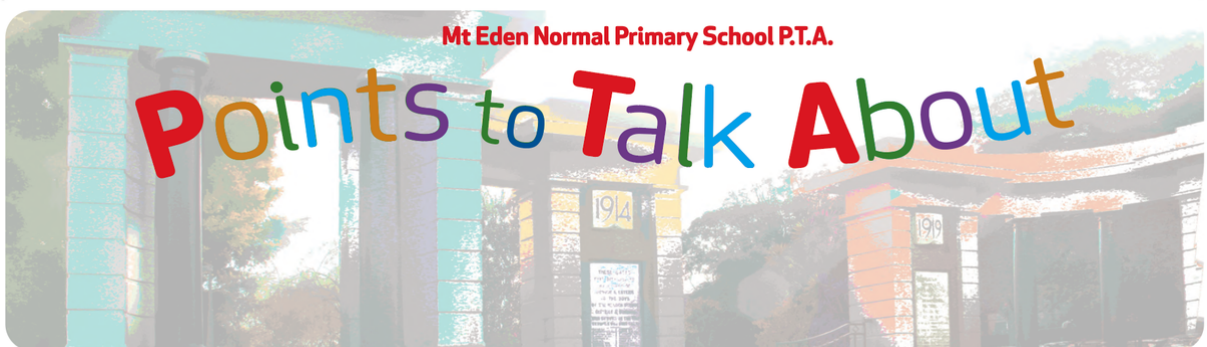

Reusable Wraps

Keep the kid's sandwiches fresh with these brilliant beeswax wraps, great for covering leftovers in the fridge too! Use the warmth of your hands to shape them over food and dishes. When they need a clean, simply use cold water and mild soap. Use again and again!
