

From the Principal

Kia ora koutou,

As the year draws to a close (and my Term 4 Sabbatical nears conclusion), it's stating the obvious to say that this year has proved to be like no other, and not something any of us would wish to repeat.

Since the outset of the Pandemic, as a school and as a community, we have prioritised the goal of keeping our tamariki safe until such time as interventions such as vaccines and therapeutics were able to offer ways to safely manage the risks presented by the pandemic.

It's been incredibly tough, and I want to thank each and every parent, student and member of staff for adapting to such challenging circumstances and making the most of the situation we found ourselves in during recent months.

As we look ahead to new approaches to 'living with covid', we can be optimistic that we are better informed and better prepared than ever to confront the challenges ahead. With this in mind, I would like to take this opportunity to share what we know so far.

While some details are still subject to Ministry of Health clarification and guidance, our commitment will continue to be ensuring the safety and wellbeing of the children in our care as we focus our energy on re-connecting and re-engaging with life and learning at school next year. There will be a lot of work to do, but I believe we will continue to pull together to achieve the results our children deserve.

We will be structuring our staffing slightly differently in order to provide more learning support for all students, particularly targeted at our Y1-3 students (who have not benefited from the foundational time in class we would usually expect). We will share further details of these plans, and also include a draft of what the move to the 'Traffic Light' Covid Protection Framework will mean for the new school year.

The key message is that, as Mrs Matene has stated previously, school will be *open in full for all students*. We will, of course, continue to have contingencies in place in the event of a diagnosed case occurring within the school at any stage, which we will continue to work hard to avoid and mitigate.

I'd particularly like to thank Maria Matene, for her outstanding professionalism as Acting Principal this term, alongside Hilary Edwards and Nicky Hill. I would also like to acknowledge Martina Stevenson for stepping up into the role of Acting Associate Principal so capably, and with characteristic energy and enthusiasm.

A final newsletter for the year will go home early next week with some final information to end the term. I know a break will be welcome and well-deserved for all, but I feel as excited and enthusiastic about next year as ever, and look forward to sharing more of our plans with you soon.
