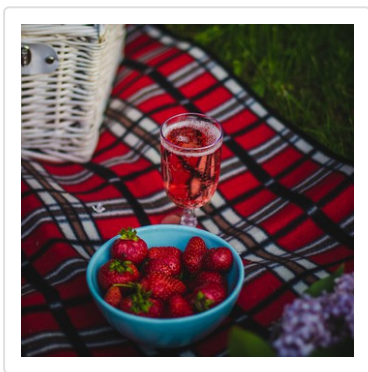

The programme aims to encourage positive family relationships.

- Practical step-by-step suggestions for parents of 3 to 5 year olds, to help handle everyday family situations
- An encouraging and supportive learning environment
- Strategies to help parents manage challenging behaviors



What is covered in the programme?

- Connecting with your child through play
- Using praise to build your child's self-esteem
- How to use praise and small rewards to motivate your child
- Setting limits
- Helping your child to develop life-long skills through positive discipline

You may find it beneficial if two adults from the family/whānau attend the course so that you can support each other in implementing the strategies. You may also prefer to attend alone if multiple family members attending is not possible, or if you feel that you will be able to share more openly with the group if you attend alone. Let us know what is going to work best for you.

- Meet once a week for 2.5 hours
